We are offering one \$2,500 scholarship this year. The scholarship is available to high school seniors who meet eligibility requirements. See General Instructions below for additional information about completing this application.

Eligibility Requirements:

High School seniors, living in Beaufort County or graduating from a public or private school in Beaufort County, who will pursue an education in visual arts (including, but not limited to photography, graphic design, textile arts, ceramics, sculpture, and architecture), are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The applicant must be accepted into a 2 or 4-year institution of higher learning. **Complete applications will include a transcript, two letters of recommendation, a hard copy portfolio of your work, and a 250+ word essay about integrating visual arts into long-term career goals.** Financial need may be considered, but is not criteria for the award.
