This large graphic leaf, made using freezer paper to form the design templates, can be made as the final 24” x 24” piece, or combined with additional blocks to make a stunning quilt.

Materials

Basic sewing supplies, rotary cutter, pins, scissors, sewing machine with regular foot (do not use a ¼” foot). Seam ripper, ruler, etc., large cutting mat like 24” x 36”

This is a great quilt for using your accumulated scraps. Use small amounts (1/4 yards are great or fat quarters) of fabrics in a range of colors that go from light to dark. Please don’t bring whole yards or large amounts! Batiks, solids, or textures work well, smaller scale commercial prints are fine, too. Hand-dyes are wonderful to use, as well as wild graphics. Add small amounts (1/8 yard or so) of neon or bright fabric like lime green or fuchsia if you have it on hand.



Colored pencils in at least 3 colors, sharpie medium point permanent marker, pink or yellow highlighter, at least 5 running feet of freezer paper, about 2 running feet of blue painter’s tape.
