Smooth Sailing – Storm at Sea Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Standard presser foot
- ¼" presser foot
- Thread – Diana recommends Aurifil 50 weight thread
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Standard quilting ruler – Diana recommends Creative Grids 6.5" x 12.5", but you can use what you have on hand
- Iron and pressing surface
- Best Press, starch, or sizing
- Fabric marking tool – Diana recommends a Frixion pen, but you can use what you have on hand
- Sewing notions such as pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.
- Studio 180 Design Tools:
 - Diamond Rects Tool – Required
 - Square² Tool – Required
 - Invisigrip applied to the back of the tools – this is optional, but Diana recommends this to make cutting easier
- Pattern: Smooth Sailing and companion wall hanging – provided to you free of charge

You will have the option of purchasing the tools at a discount prior to class from Wish Upon a Quilt. A discount code will be provided to you.

Fabric Requirements for Wall Hanging: (According to the colors on the companion page – you can choose whatever colors you like)

- Black: ½ yard
- Light Gray: 1/3 yard
- Dark Gray: 1/8 yard
- Pink: 1/3 yard
- Backing and batting: 5/8 yard
